



Martin County Community Service Volunteer Policy

Martin County Habitat welcomes volunteers who are required by a court to complete community service. While all of our volunteer opportunities are open to such volunteers, the timeframe required for the hours' completion typically means that an individual will volunteer either in construction or at our Habitat ReStore.

To be eligible to use Habitat for Humanity of Martin County as a source for completing community service, your sentence must involve:

1. No second offense convictions of a violent nature
2. No convictions of an offense of a sexual nature
3. No convictions of theft or burglary
4. Written confirmation of the number of community service hours to be completed.

Additionally, you must:

5. Complete and sign a Volunteer Registration and Liability Waiver Form.
6. Complete and sign a Community Service Acknowledgment Form.
7. Schedule yourself for desired hours in construction at www.habitatmartin.volunteerhub.com. If you do not have access to a computer, other arrangements can be made. Hours for the ReStore will be arranged with the ReStore Manager.
8. Sign in upon arrival at the work location.
9. Sign out when you leave the work site. This will verify your attendance and hours.
10. Once your hours are complete, Habitat will sign off any necessary paperwork for the courts and can provide a printout of your hours.

Please note: Habitat for Humanity of Martin County reserves the right to terminate this agreement for community service if the participant is in any way unproductive, disruptive, or in any other way negatively impacts the accomplishment of the daily goals.
